

Quilt Entry Categories

1. Handwork

Entries can be any size. This category features hand applique, hand quilting and includes English paper piecing.

- A. Personally quilted, perimeter 160" or less
- B. Personally quilted, perimeter 161" or more
- C. Quilted by someone else, perimeter 160" or less
- D. Quilted by someone else, perimeter 161" or more

2. Machine Appliqué

Entries feature machine appliqué work.

- A. Personally quilted, any size
- B. Quilted by someone else, any size

3. Wall Hangings

Entries are for quilts which have an intended use as a wall hanging.

- A. Personally quilted, perimeter 160" or less
- B. Personally quilted, perimeter 161" or more
- C. Quilted by someone else, perimeter 160" or less
- D. Quilted by someone else, perimeter 161" or more

4. Traditionally Pieced Quilts

Entries feature piecing.

- A. Personally quilted, perimeter 199" or less
- B. Personally quilted, perimeter 200" or more
- C. Quilted by someone else, perimeter 199" or less
- D. Quilted by someone else, perimeter 200" - 274"
- E. Quilted by someone else, perimeter 275"-349"
- F. Quilted by someone else, perimeter 350" or more

5. Paper and Foundation Pieced Quilts

Entries in this category must contain paper or foundation piecing as the main focus of the quilt.

- A. Personally quilted, any size
- B. Quilted by someone else, perimeter 199" or less
- C. Quilted by someone else, perimeter 200" or more



6. Modern Quilts

Modern quilts are primarily functional and inspired by modern design. Some or several of the following characteristics should be present to clearly identify the quilt as "modern": bold colors and prints, high contrast and graphic areas of solid color, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space and alternate grid work.

- A. Personally quilted, perimeter 160" or less
- B. Personally quilted, perimeter 161" or more
- C. Quilted by someone else, perimeter 274" or less
- D. Quilted by someone else, perimeter 275" or more

7. Group Quilts

Made by 3 or more persons, any size, technique or quilting method.

8. Special Technique

Includes miniatures, cross stitch, embroidery, whole cloth, crazy patch, cathedral window, trapunto, cheater cloth, faux chenille, photo transfer, wool on wool, non-traditional, and mixed techniques. Please specify special technique used on entry form. Items in this category may have only two layers.

- A. Personally quilted, any size
- B. Quilted by someone else, any size

9. Junior Quilters

Quilts or quilted items made by a person 18 years of age or younger regardless of size or technique. Youth quilts may be tied. There is no charge for Junior quilt submissions and one free show entry will be provided for junior exhibitors.

- A. Personally quilted or tied, any size
- B. Quilted by someone else, any size

10. Art Quilt

Entries in this category must be designed by the entrant. Traditional blocks used in innovative ways may fit into this category, but unusual coloration alone does not constitute an original design. No size or technique limitations apply, but all workmanship must be by the entering artist(s). Commercial pattern designs are not eligible for this category.

11. Household Use/Garments

Includes quilted clothing and wearable accessories, table runners, kitchen or sewing room accessories, pillows, etc.

12. For Display Only

Entries are for display only and will not be judged.
