## **Fabric Supplies Needed:**

- 4 repeats of a multi-colored **large-scale** print (florals work great!)
  - Avoid prints that include straight lines
  - 3 Yards is a perfect amount and will include border fabric if your repeat is 12" or 24".
  - Example: If the repeat of your fabric is 24" you will need 2- 2/3 yards of fabric. However, if you get 3 yds. you will have enough to cut your borders from the length of the fabric!
  - *Do not prewash your fabric*
- Sashing fabric.  
***Depending on the size of your quilt 2 yards is generally enough to sash and bind your quilt.*** It is OK to wait until the blocks are finished to select the sashing.

## **Sewing Supplies:**

- Rotary cutter
- Ruler (6 x 24-inch works great),
- Cutting Mat
- Contrasting Thread
- Pins
- Sewing Machine and sewing kit/supplies
