## Fabric Supplies Needed:

- 4 repeats of a multi-colored large-scale print (florals work great!)
- Avoid prints that include straight lines
- 3 Yards is a perfect amount and will include border fabric if your repeat is $12^{\prime \prime}$ or $24^{\prime \prime}$.
- Example: If the repeat of your fabric is 24 " you will need $2-2 / 3$ yards of fabric. However, if you get 3 yds . you will have enough to cut your borders from the length of the fabric!
- Do not prewash your fabric
- Sashing fabric.

Depending on the size of your quilt 2 yards is generally enough to sash and bind your quilt. It is OK to wait until the blocks are finished to select the sashing.

## Sewing Supplies:

- Rotary cutter
- Ruler (6 x 24 -inch works great),
- Cutting Mat
- Contrasting Thread
- Pins
- Sewing Machine and sewing kit/supplies
